

FAITH WORKS PART 1

Faith alone justified. But faith that justifies is never alone.

- John Calvin

ILLUS: DR ALFRED ADLER "TRUST ONLY IN MOVEMENT.

"TRUST ONLY IN MOVEMENT.

LIFE HAPPENS AT THE LEVEL OF ACTION."

James is addressing the question of REAL - "How do I know..."

How do I handle TRIALS? | Do | PERSEVERE with joy or do | DOUBT God?

How do I handle TEMPTATION? | Do | BLAME or do | TRUST what God said?

How do I handle the SCRIPTURES? | Do | RESPOND to them?

How do I handle PEOPLE? | Do | follow God's LEAD or am | PARTIAL?

How do I handle FAITH? | Is my faith LIVING or DEAD ?

Faith is a lot like calories...

you can't really see them, but you can sure see their results!

James starts with two questions —

What use is it, my brethren, if a man says he has faith, but he has no works? Can that faith save him? James 2:14

THE HELPFUL QUES. What use is a faith without works?
THE GENUINE QUES. Can that faith save?

FAITH USED 16X IN JAS 11X IN THIS PASSAGE IN THE 5X OUTSIDE THIS PASSAGE, FAITH IS ALWAYS POSITIVE

James' line of questioning implies:

- That there is a version of 'faith' that does not SAVE
- It is not about a MATURE faith v an IMMATURE faith...

it is essentially contrasting **SAVING** (Living) faith with <u>DEAD</u> (no) faith! James highlights the truth with this: 'if a man says he has faith...'

POSSESSION of faith > **PROFESSION** of faith

..people with dead faith always substitute words for deeds...

Consistent Teaching of the Bible on This

Prophets - God doesn't delight in sacrifices...but 'possession' of faith *Is* 1:11-18 **John the Baptist** warned against the false faith *Matt* 3:7-9

Jesus - the Sermon on the Mount Matt 5:16,7:21

Jesus - You will know faith by what you _____ Luke 6:43-44; Matt 7:16-20; 12:33

Jesus - to Nicodemus John 3:2 v John 3:3

Jesus would not commit to empty professors John 2:23-25; 8:30-31

Paul taught faith created more than talk Rom 2:6,14:12, Eph 2:10; Titus 1:16

Notes from The Heights Series: In Real Life

James is very certain about two things -

Knowledge about something is not the same as <u>TRUST</u> in something Knowing is *not necessarily* the same as *REDEMPTION*

The issue in James 2 is this: **DOES JAMES CONTRADICT PAUL?**

NO!

MORE NEXT WEEK

Sharp Clarification -

NEITHER James, nor Paul suggest "Salvation is by works!"
BOTH will agree that salvation is BY grace, THROUGH faith, and
UNTO good works

How Do I Recognize False Faith?

#1 - False Faith does not TRANSLATE PRACTICALLY w15-16

15 If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and be filled," and yet you do not give them what is necessary for their body, what use is that?

Living faith expresses itself in **COMPASSION** motivated by **LOVE**

17 But whoever has the world's goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth. 19 We shall know by this that we are of the truth, and shall assure our heart before Him...

MATT 25:31-FF

1 John 3:17-19

It is an empty confession that never fleshes out into <u>ACTION</u>

#2 - False Faith exists in a VACUUM vv17-18

17 Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself. 18 But someone may well say, "You have faith, and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works."

False faith has nothing to **VALIDATE** it - it is 'by itself'

Real Faith can not help but to be **SHOWN** ('show' = exhibit)

Spirit-empowered deeds will ALWAYS accompany spirit-filled faith

#3 - False Faith is less than **DEMON** faith vv19-20

19 You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder. 20 But are you willing to recognize, you foolish fellow, that faith without works is useless?

- confuses knowledge or awareness with saving faith or <u>REDEMPTION</u>
- mixes up **EMOTION** and **DEVOTION**
- has no WILLFUL OBEDIENCE

"Faith and works are bound up in the same bundle. He that obeys God trusts God; and he that trusts God obeys God. He that is without faith is without works; and he that is without works is without faith."
