BEHOLD!

By His death, Jesus has destroyed death, and by His resurrection He has torn away the gates of the grave.”
- Charles Spurgeon

1 Now after the Sabbath, as the first day of the week began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb. 2 And **behold**, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it. 3 His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. 4 And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men. 5 But the angel answered and said to the women, “Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. 6 He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. 7 And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. **Behold**, I have told you.”

behold = Gk:*idou* - perceive; consider; discern; take heed; to **SEE**

An amazing paradox: The ‘unseen God’ is incredibly **VISUAL** !

CF 1 TIM 6:16; ROM 1:20

8 Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, 9 for you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:8 niv

**There are ‘beholds’ all over the Bible
It is the gospel in a WORD!**

① **SEE** that there is a **CHOICE** !

26 **Behold**, I set before you today a blessing and a curse: 27 the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you today; 28 and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known. Deuteronomy 11:26-28 nkj

② **SEE** that God took a **PERSONAL** interest!

10 Then the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid, for **behold**, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. 11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. 12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger.”
Luke 2:10-12 nkj

③ **SEE** that there is a **PLAN** !

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “**Behold!** The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”
John 1:29

John’s referenced the OT story of **ABRAHAM AND ISAAC**
Genesis 22

④ **SEE** that the **PROVISION** is sufficient!

4 Pilate then went out again, and said to them, “**Behold**, I am bringing Him out to you, that you may know that I find no fault in Him.”
5 Then Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And Pilate said to them, “**Behold** the Man!”
15 But they cried out, “Away with Him, away with Him! Crucify Him!”
Pilate said to them, “Shall I crucify your King?”
The chief priests answered, “We have no king but Caesar!”
16 Then he delivered Him to them to be crucified. Then they took Jesus and led Him away.
John 19:4-5,15-16 nkj

There was **PROOF of God’s Concept**
Matthew 27:51-54

⑤ **SEE** that there is proof of **LIFE** !

4 And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that **behold**, two men stood by them in shining garments. 5 Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but is risen!”
Luke 24:4-6 nkj

BEHOLD - He is not FINISHED!

— You can be a **CHILD** of God!

Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! 1 John 3:1 nkj

— GOD’S plan initiates a complete **REBOOT** !

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; **behold**, all things have become new. 2 Corinthians 5:17 nkj

— He will come **AGAIN** !

3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, “**Behold**, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He shall dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself shall be among them, 4 and He shall wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there shall no longer be any death; there shall no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away. “ 5 And He who sits on the throne said, “**Behold**, I am making all things new.”
